WHAT'S IN A LABEL?

Orang-utans' forests are being cleared for palm oil plantations.

Look for products that contain RSPO* certified palm oil and you can help save orang-utans.

Or, if you wish to avoid palm oil altogether, look out for any products with these ingredients:

Vegetable oil (if the food has a high saturated fat content)

Sodium Laureth Sulphate (can also be from coconut)

Sodium Lauryl Sulphates (can also be from ricinus oil)

Sodium dodecyl Sulphate (SDS or NaDS)

Palmate

Palm Oil Kernal

Palmitate

CHEMICALS CONTAINING PALM OIL

Steareth -2

Sodium Lauryl Sulphate
